

MARCH LAMB IX RALLY

Philadelphia Region, SCCA **Brandywine Motorsport Club** Mid Atlantic Rally Series

SUNDAY, APRIL 2, 2006

The BRANDYWINE MOTORSPORT CLUB presents its first rally of 2006. This event is a sponsored by the rally cooperative consisting of the organizations listed above. The **MARCH LAMB** automobile road rally traverses roads through Cecil Co. Maryland and New Castle Co Delaware. Average speeds are at or below the posted limits. A challenge will be offered in most legs to correctly apply the rules of the rally (General Instructions/GIs). It is very important to pre-register in order to receive the GIs and prepare ahead of time. It is even more vitally important for this event since it is a course following event where the correct course or timing is often determined by correct application of the GIs. Note also the 1-hour time change and try not to be 1 hour late.

Registration and Start:

PARK-N-RIDE lot approx. 1/2 mile north of 195/State Route 896 in Newark, DE at intersection of SR 896 & SR 4.

Finish:

Matilda's Restaurant about ¼ mile from the start location.

Awards:

Top 25% in each class. Class X may be formed from SCCA E, L, S for trophy awards as defined in the General Instructions. (approx. 6 PM)

Schedule:

Registration	Opens 12 Noon
Rally School	12:50 – 1:00
First car starts	1:30 PM
Awards	After scoring is done

Equipment:

As defined for SCCA Classes E, L, S. Novice Class must conform to SCCA Class S.

Participants:

A minimum and maximum of two persons per car is allowed. Small children are excepted but all minors are required to have Minor Release Form signed by both parents or guardians.

Classes:

SCCA Classes E, L, S are provided. Additionally a Novice Class (N) is offered for entries with neither team member having >10 events experience and using SCCA Class S equipment. Class X – SCCA Classes (E, L, S) with handicapping per GIs, if necessary.

General Instructions will be mailed to all competitors whose pre-paid entry is received by March 24th. Advanced registration and receipt of General Instructions gives you the rules for the rally. BMC requires at least 15 pre-registered entries by the above date. Send Entry to the Registrar:
